

## INTERNSHIPS

If you wish to receive academic credit for work-related experiences *outside* of Miami University (e.g. research laboratories, consulting firms, zoos, museums, industrial laboratories, government agencies), you can enroll in BIO 340 (Internship) for credit. If you only want Experiential Learning credit instead of biology hours for the major, you can sign up for 0 credit hours of Bio 340 and it will still count for EL.

*Be aware that Miami University WILL charge you tuition for any BIO 340 credit hours you earn off-campus during summer or winter terms. You will NOT be charged if you register for 0 hours of credit.*

To receive credit, you must:

1. Arrange for a faculty sponsor. You should look through the list of faculty (<https://www.miamioh.edu/cas/academics/departments/biology/research/research-areas/index.html>) and their research to find a suitable sponsor and then contact that person directly to set up a meeting.
