Scope: Who is Covered by this Policy?

All undergraduates and prospective undergraduate students.

Policy

The <u>Undergraduate</u> Fresh Start Policy is designed to help Miami University <u>undergraduate</u> students return to good academic standing after an absence of at least two calendar years. Students who have been academically suspended or dismissed or who voluntarily left the University with a cumulative GPA below 2.00 are eligible for Fresh Start after a two-year absence.

Fresh Start status must be requested within one semester (fall or spring) of completing at least 12 graded credit hours on wf $\,^{\vee}$ M $\,^{\vee}$ M

ting that all Miami University credit hours earned prior to re-enrollment will the following conditions:

es taken prior to Fresh Start are excluded from the cumulative grade point ge calculation, and the student starts with a new cumulative grade point ge.

s from all coursework taken at Miami University after Fresh Start will be a calculating eligibility for graduation with honors.

osing to re-enroll under the Fresh Start policy are subject to the academic and degree requirements in effect at the time of their re-entry. Fresh Start to re-deplace their major or majors, or re-apply for admission to the major if required, and must complete all current academic requirements. Fresh applicable only to associate and baccalaureate degrees and may be one time. Following re-enrollment, students opting for Fresh Start must diami a minimum of 50 percent of the total hours required for their degree
